Primary School Admissions - deadline 15th January 2019

If you have not yet applied for a primary school place for you child if they are transferring in September 2019, then please speak to us this week and we will be able to help you. If you have already applied then please show Chris, Jenette or Faye the confirmation email you received. Remember... you can apply for up to 6 local primary schools and we recommend that you complete all 6 preferences.
