Sports Day

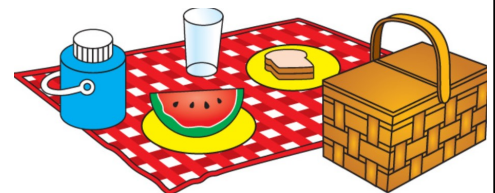
