We wish all of our children and families at THNS a safe, healthy and happy summer holiday break.

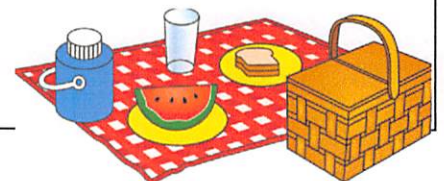
End of term picnic -- weather permitting!
